

A Word from the Recreation Minister

The verse that gives Sports Crusaders its purpose is 1 Corinthians 9:22b (NASB) "I have become all things to all people, so that I may by all means save some." It is a verse that should challenge each of us in our mission to reach this area.

When the Family Life Center (FLC) opened in January of 2000, without realizing it, First Baptist Church took this verse to heart. The FLC opened as a safe place for kids to go after school and "hang out." It was to be a place that the church could use to impact the community. It has very much fulfilled this mission.

That mission was expanded 25 years ago when Upward basketball and cheer became a ministry of First Baptist Church. It made an immediate impact. That first year, Upward started right after the city's youth league ended. It was so popular that the second year the city chose not to have a league and Upward has continued ever since.

This past season we had approximately 170 children involved. We had over 35 volunteer coaches, many different people working concessions, running the score clock, reffing games, announcing the teams, sharing devotions, etc. Thank you to everyone who gave of their time. Next year come and check it out. You'll be amazed at all that goes on.

I feel it is important to recognize a few individuals who worked hard behind the scenes to see that Upward was successful. Cheryl Carter, our prayer coordinator, who from the first day of sign-ups, kept us up on how to pray for Upward. Joe Hoover, our concessions coordinator, who made sure no one went hungry.
