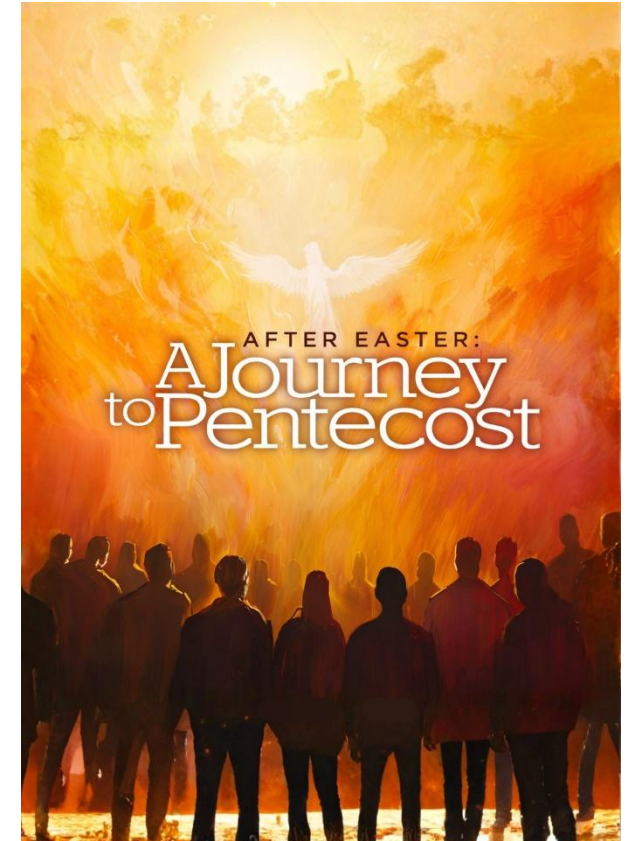

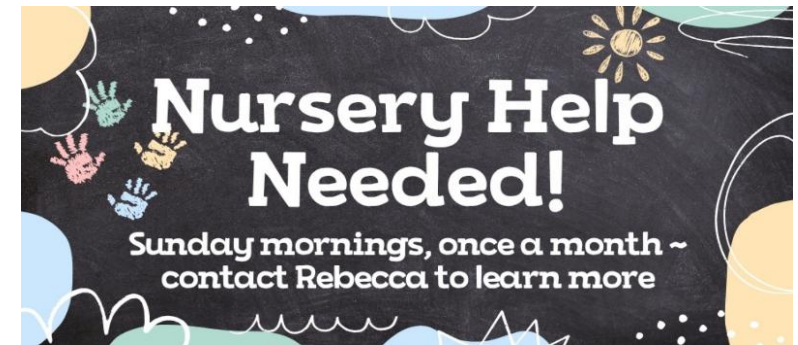
A Word from the Pastor

One of the great blessings of being a part of FBC Cassville is that we are a praying church. I can't tell you how many times people have walked up to me since we got back from Israel and told me how fervently they had been praying for us. But even more are those who are praying for people who are struggling with major health crises and their families! Your prayers matter. Your prayers help. Your prayers make a difference. Keep praying! Prayer is one of the four devotions that our church is built upon, and we need to constantly make it a priority. Keep Praying.

The second area I would like to talk about is our nation's 250th birthday this summer. The deacons recently asked me what we're planning for the anniversary event, and honestly, it hadn't crossed my mind yet. They have volunteered to move our annual church picnic to Sunday, July 5th, and wondered how we could amp it up and/or make it more outreach focused. I can assure you that we are working on some exciting plans for that evening. We would also be open to suggestions if you have ideas that we might be able to integrate. As of right now, we are planning on cooking hot dogs (free to any participant) and possibly having watermelon too. Zack is investigating some live music options. I have also spoken to Alan Lane, our new Director of Missions for Barry County Baptists, and asked if the churches could coordinate July 4 plans through the associational office and he is on board. Please feel free to make suggestions!

Finally, Gary Stiles and his crew of incredible volunteers are in the final stages of getting our new church sign finished and placed in front of our office near the 7th and West Street intersection. This sign is a basic replica of the original 1947 neon sign that stood in front of the church for decades. Johnny Crawford found the neon portion under the north stairway. Although the neon was no longer working, it has been converted to "faux neon", a type of LED, and it is mounted on the original sign board. The lower portion that was originally a changeable letter sign has been replaced with an outdoor flat panel tv, which is going to be beautiful and clear. Placement is a little dicey between building codes, parking spaces and a utility pole, it will not be perfect; but it will be a tremendous nod to those First Baptist members who went before us!
