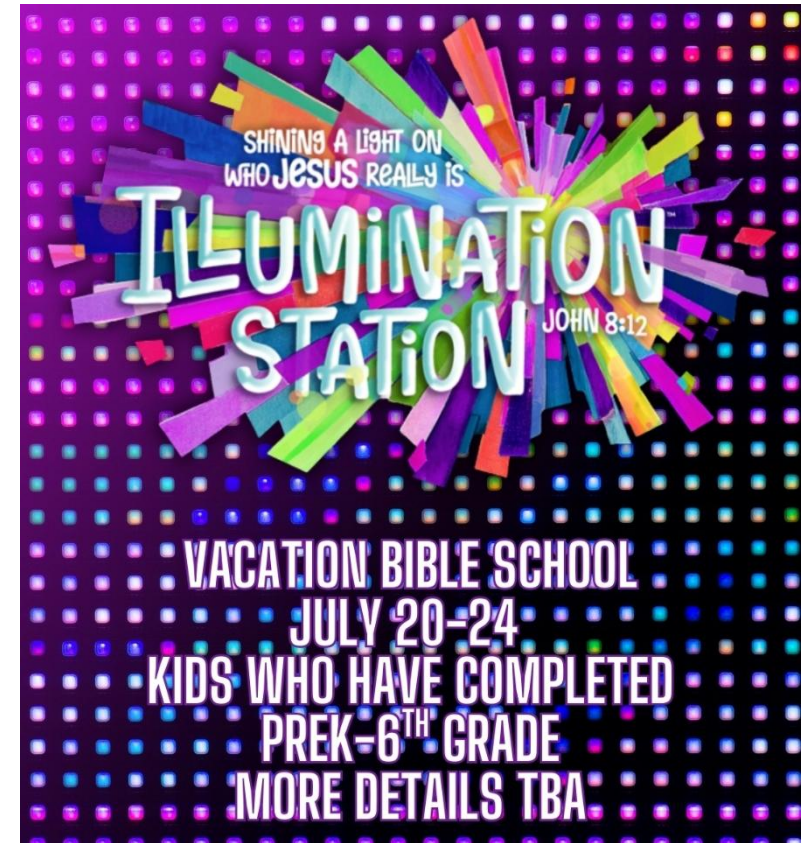
A Word from the Children's Director
